2023 FVSU TAILGATING POLICY and RULES

- Tailgating is defined as parking in a designated location/or area and/or setting up nonpermanent facilities (such as tents and tables) to consume food and beverages prior to an officially sanctioned University event, to which, the public is invited, and the event has been approved for tailgating.
- Individuals attending events at FVSU are expected to conduct themselves in a manner respectful of the nature and character of the College. Persons acting in a disruptive, disrespectful or disorderly manner may be asked to leave the premises or be subject to citation. Students may also be charged with a violation of the code of Student Conduct.
- FVSU does not sanction the consumption or possession of alcoholic beverages by underage person; nor does it sanction the violation of federal, state, local law.
- Tailgating activities must not interfere with or obstruct the passage of emergency vehicles; These vehicles must be able to always move through the Tailgating Area.
 Parking in access lanes and along the Tree Line will be strictly prohibited. Violators will be towed at owner's expense.
- All tailgating must be restricted to the designated areas.
- No solicitation or vendors will be allowed in tailgating areas.
- The University is not responsible for your vehicle or the possessions within your vehicle.
- Please take precautions in securing your supplies and other belongings when entering and exiting the tailgating area.
- Please be considerate of those tailgating around you, as they may have different preferences regarding the property, types of music, profane language and actions of others. Remember, it is FVSU's intention to promote a family atmosphere.
- Please ensure that propane-fueled grills are operated properly. No open flame sources to include bonfires, metal drum fires, etc. will be allowed during tailgating.
- Please do not empty charcoal grills onto the ground; this may cause a smoldering fire to rekindle, causing damage to the football practice fields and nearby buildings or injury to others. Metal drums are available to dispose of all charcoal.
- Trash, waste, and other materials should not be dumped on the University grounds. Trash

receptacles are conveniently located throughout the tailgating area for trash disposal. Persons responsible for not cleaning their area may be denied participation in future events. If trash receptacles are full, please use large, heavy duty plastic bags to secure your waste or trash.

- No motorcycles are allowed in the tailgating area.
- FVSU is governed by the Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia and adheres to all federal and state laws (Website www.usg.edu).

- FVSU is a Tobacco FREE CAMPUS/ SMOKE FREE CAMPUS
- A game ticket or current student ID is required for entrance into the tailgating area on Saturday.
